

## Wordly Wise – Section E

- Answer questions with a complete sentence.
- Use key words from the question.
- Underline the vocabulary word.
- Do not use banned words to begin a sentence.

### **Example 1**

Example Question:	How can one satisfy a craving for chocolate?
Find the Key Words:	<del>How can</del> <u>one (can) satisfy a craving for chocolate?</u>
Use the Key Words to form a complete sentence and underline the vocabulary word:	One can satisfy a <u>craving</u> for chocolate by eating or drinking chocolate.

### **Example 2**

Example Question:	What is the meaning of consumed as it is used in the passage?
Find the Key Words:	<del>What is</del> <u>the meaning of consumed as it is used in the passage?</u>
Use the Key Words to form a complete sentence and underline the vocabulary word:	The meaning of <u>consumed</u> as it is used in the passage is "drank".
